GOAL

To explore **use cases in order to demo an ag data wallet** and develop a **formal concept note & high level technical document** with social, legal and tech specifications for creation of an ag data wallet.

ABOUT THIS SESSION

How might we maximize the value of data for every farmer and rancher through supporting more understandable data use agreements that enable greater individual control of data through trusted intermediaries? This series will explore the concept of an ag data wallet, which secures storage of important farm and field level data under the control of the data owner. But “wallet” is simultaneously too limiting; it might be better to think of the combination of a wallet, a safe deposit box, and a brokerage account. Use cases explored will test ag data wallet modules that will support data management by trusted third parties through secure permissions.
